Check or Credit Card — Give a tribute gift in honor of or in memory of a loved one, or give to a current fund. Appreciated Stock and Other Complex Assets — Donating appreciated securities, rather than selling the assets and donating the cash proceeds, can be a smart way to minimize your taxes* and maximize your giving impact during your lifetime. Examples include publicly-traded stocks, mutual funds and more complex vehicles such as closely-held stock or business interests (LLC, LPs), pending careful review from our Gift Acceptance Committee.

Life Insurance, Bequest or Planned Gift — Consider naming a gift for the future or a planned gift that can benefit both you and your favorite cause. Planned gifts offered through the Foundation include charitable gift annuities, charitable remainder trusts, and other arrangements to fit your personal situation.

IRA Rollover — Individuals 70½ and older can transfer up to \$100,000 from an IRA to any public charity, including the Jewish Community Foundation. Rollovers can be deposited into a Community Action, Designated, Field of Interest or Scholarship Fund; the IRS does not allow them for deposit into a Donor Advised Fund.

Real Estate and Tangible Personal Property — Gifts of real estate and personal property such as arts and antiques may be accepted, pending careful review from our Gift Acceptance Committee.
