# Remaining Resilient Together

*“Much of Judaism is about the shape and structure of our togetherness.”* RABBI JONATHAN SACKS



Hamas’s terrorist attack in Israel on October 7, 2023, was the most shocking and horrific moment in Jewish history since the Holocaust, and the warfare and violence in Gaza, Southern Lebanon, and throughout Israel has sparked anxiety and tension throughout the region and around the world. Israelis are suffering directly from the violence and its aftermath; Jews everywhere feel less safe than we did before October 7. At the same time, we feel the driving need to strengthen our bonds with Israel, to support Israelis who are sacrificing their own lives and their families’ welfare to defend their state, and to combat the rise of Antisemitism and anti-Israel rhetoric around the world and in our communities.



From its founding in 1972, the Foundation and its endowment have supported our local Jewish community and provided funding for aid to Israel. But since last October’s terrorism, we and our donors have increased our generosity to both Israel and the needs of our community. Whatever our individual views on international politics may be, we have come together to say loudly and proudly that we are Jews who care about protecting our people, providing care to those who need it, and offering solace to those who suffer. At the Foundation we are proud to provide the vehicle for that funding, and proud to partner with the Jewish Federation of Greater Hartford in:

- providing aid to Israel
- increasing security in our community, and
- fighting Antisemitism locally and around the world.



We are all central to supporting one another and our Jewish values. **The Foundation will always emphasize a strong sense of belonging, pride and connection to Judaism and each other.**

The war has spiked a significant rise in Antisemitism, and it is hard to find allies amid the loudness. Listening to community members

is key to navigating through these situations. This helps us better understand the community’s needs so we can grant immediate funds.

We have issued Community Grants for humanitarian aid in Israel, and locally for mental health services provided through Jewish Family Services, for security consultations to Jewish institutions from our first-ever Community Security Director at our Jewish Federation, and to the children of families from Israel to attend Solomon Schechter Day School and New England Jewish Academy. We also funded JTConnect’s Antisemitism Conference with the Jewish Federation, at which more than 200 teens and parents learned how to stand up to all forms of hatred. In addition, more than \$1 million in grants were distributed to not-for-profit organizations at the request of our Donor Advised Fundholders in response to October 7.

**We are proud that the Foundation’s philanthropic support—through the wishes of our donors—has grown** since the war began. Donors are supporting Israel, and they continue supporting causes that are important to them locally. During this fraught time for Jews everywhere, the Foundation will continue to support Israel and strengthen the Jewish community in Greater Hartford and beyond.

**Together, we will remain resilient.**

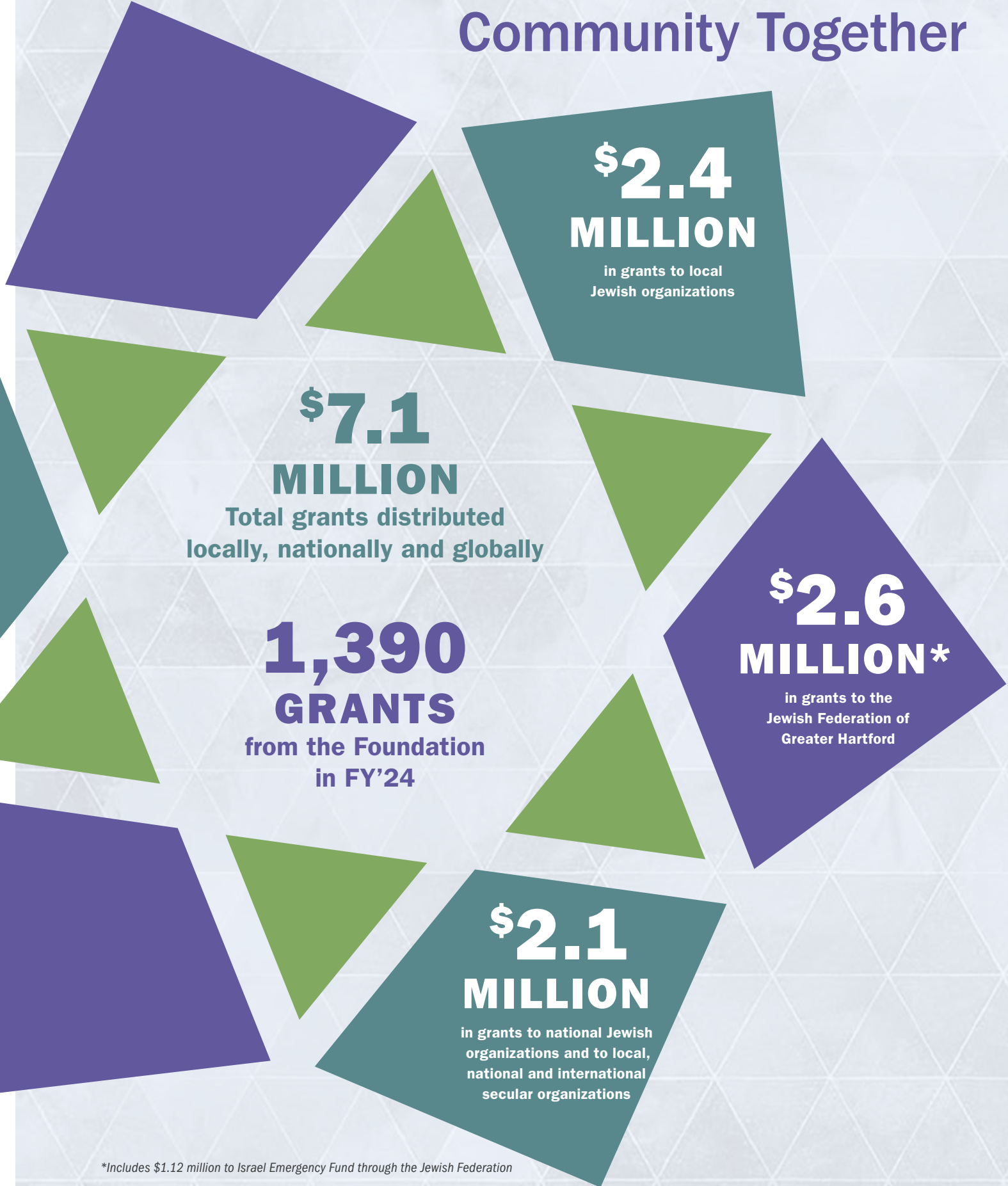

# Community Grants in Action

## A Look Back

### Grants Support Compassionate Care to Families Through Jewish Family Services

Staff and volunteers at Jewish Family Services (JFS) strive to serve families in the Jewish tradition of caring and compassion, creating positive change for multiple generations. Just as JFS supports the health and wellbeing of people, the Foundation's Community Grants are supporting the expansion of JFS's programs and services, including new revenue through JFS Care at Home.

"JFS Care at Home has been wildly successful," said Katie Hanley, Chief Executive Officer of JFS. "We have helped people live in their homes as they age by providing quality comprehensive care tailored to each family's individual circumstances. It took many years to get here—especially during COVID—but Care at Home is now supporting our growth."



The Foundation's Community Grants to Jewish Family Services are supporting its growth and outreach, including hosting focus groups to help community members process the tragic events unfolding in Israel.

When JFS saw an increase in the need for mental health services, particularly after October 7, grants allowed staff to immediately respond.

"We facilitated 19 support groups to help people—from seniors to students—find support and strength to process the events unfolding in Israel," said Katie.

Grants also funded hiring a mental health community liaison who conducted group trainings with families that helped 1,000 young people.

A few years ago, a Community Grant supported hiring a consultant to review JFS's mental health clinic operations and conduct focus groups with staff, resulting in a comprehensive report with recommendations for strategic growth.

"We shared the report with our Board and it created new energy at JFS," explained Katie.

"We hired new people who provided fresh perspectives and helped us focus on priorities based on the report," Katie continued. "We couldn't have afforded to do all of this work without the Foundation's grants."

*Board-directed grants from the Foundation's Unrestricted Funds support our community. Here's a look back at a few forward-thinking investments that might not have been possible without the Foundation's support.*

### Hillel Programs Thrive and Increase Student Engagement

When donors open Unrestricted Funds, their collective endowed investment unleashes the financial power to strengthen local Jewish nonprofits with JCF's Community Grants. These Board-directed grants have provided the Hillel programs at the University of Hartford and the University of Connecticut with opportunities to expand their capacity for long-term growth.

Cumulative grants to both Hillel programs let the Executive Directors focus on strategic initiatives to sustain and grow their organizations, while hiring staff who can focus their attention on providing quality programs and outreach to students.

"Grants from the Foundation significantly changed my job," said Lisa Langsner, Executive Director of UHart Hillel. "It freed up time to meet with donors and fundraising officers and raise money that increased our annual operation fund over one hundred percent," she continued. "It also gave me the capacity to run a capital campaign, raising nearly one million dollars for construction of a new Hillel Center and partially endowing my position."

"We filled our Engagement Associate position during COVID with grants, and it helped us not only survive but thrive," Lisa explained. "We tripled our engagement in three years and currently engage fifty percent of our Jewish student population in our activities."

UConn Hillel experienced similar growth using a grant to hire an Ezra Innovation Fellow, which helped the staff exceed its goals. "Having this Fellow on board enabled Hillel to engage and support more students than previous years, which was especially critical in the eight months following October seventh," said Edina Oestreicher, Executive Director of UConn Hillel. "The Fellow meets one-on-one with students and develops in-depth relationships."

"This position also freed up my time to increase our development efforts," she continued. "As of May 2024, we surpassed our fundraising and engagement goals for the year and we are looking forward to a strong year ahead."

# Grants Foster Growth of Synagogues

The Foundation offers Micro Grants and Capacity-Building Grants to local synagogues through a competitive grant application process. The applications are evaluated by the Foundation's Grants Committee, which provides recommendations for final approval by the Board of Trustees. Here's a round-up of a few grants in action:

## Beth David Synagogue

Whether it's hearing the sweet sounds of a capella during Simchat Torah, listening to a thought-provoking presentation from a scholar-in-residence, or engaging in strategic planning sessions with expert consultants, the Foundation's grants are strengthening the vitality and growth of Beth David Synagogue.

"The Jewish Community Foundation's grants allow us to think out of the box and create meaningful spiritual experiences, and puts programs in our reach that we otherwise couldn't afford," said Rabbi Yitzchok Adler at Beth David.

For the first time in 29 years, Beth David has an executive director based on a recommendation from a consultant to expand the organization's capacity. "Without the Foundation's capacity-building grants, this position would have never been created," said Rabbi Adler.

## Congregation Beth Israel (CBI)

When CBI hosted a gathering for new members in 2020, it didn't draw a lot of attendance. The following year, using a Micro Grant from the Foundation, CBI revamped the event into a festive celebration featuring face painting, games, a barbeque and musical entertainment outside the temple. The party has grown into an annual signature event called Celebrate CBI, which draws approximately 200 attendees including new and prospective members, neighbors and police officers.

"The event strengthens our community through meaningful connections," said Rabbi Pincus. "We've gained between ten to fifteen new families each year after they attend Celebrate CBI and congregant contributions for the event now make this annual celebration possible," he continued. "We are thankful to the Foundation for providing Micro Grants to expand our activities and for helping us grow our endowment."

## Farmington Valley Jewish Congregation — Emek Shalom (FVJC-ES)

The Mini Minyan and Family Education Programs at FVJC-ES offer parents and their children an introduction to Jewish values and ethics, and parenting through a Jewish lens. When FVJC-ES staff wanted to enhance the Family Education curriculum, they hired a consultant through a grant from the Foundation. As a result, 41 families have explored their commitment to living Jewishly.

"Stronger programming and content from the consultant provided deeper engagement for families and compelled many parents to become members," said Rebekah Goldman, Senior Rabbi of FVJC-ES. "It also provided interfaith partners with meaningful knowledge about the faith in which they are raising their children."

Michael’s leadership activities include serving as Chair of the Board of Directors of the Connecticut Museum of Culture and History and a member of the Board of Directors of the Jewish Federation of Greater Hartford.

Together, Shari and Michael will use their new Donor Advised Fund to recommend grants to their favorite organizations while strengthening the community. Here are their thoughts on their new partnership with the Foundation.

## Why did you open a Donor Advised Fund at the Jewish Community Foundation?

While there are certainly a number of Donor Advised Funds available through various entities,

it became clear to us that using the Jewish Community Foundation is a “win-win”; it allows us to do our charitable giving in an extremely flexible, easy way and it benefits and supports our local Jewish community.

## What are the causes you will be supporting through your fund?

We will be supporting the Jewish Federation of Greater Hartford as we have for many years. In addition, we both have leadership roles in other non-profits and support those through this process—including but not limited to—University of Connecticut, Connecticut Children’s Foundation, Connecticut Museum of Culture and History, Hartford Stage and Playhouse on Park.

We are strongly connected to our community through service and donations; this aligns with our beliefs and commitments to strengthen and support the institutions that are important to us.



# Making an Impact Together in Our Communities



## Grants Support Community Members Locally and in Israel

*During times of conflict, we stand together and uplift our community through thoughtful giving.*

The war against Israel has had ripple effects in Greater Hartford with community members navigating through tragedy and loss to find hope and strength in each other through philanthropic support. The Foundation has provided grants to organizations both here and in Israel, responding to myriad needs to keep our Jewish community resilient.

More than \$1 million in grants were distributed to nonprofits in the U.S. and in Israel at the request of Donor Advised Fundholders, in response to the war.

Local synagogues and agencies are receiving security consultations from John Colangelo, Community Security Director at the Jewish Federation, a position that was established through a Community Grant.

Community Grants also provided humanitarian aid in Israel and locally for mental health services to individuals and families provided through Jewish Family Services. In addition, grants were awarded to children of families from Israel to attend Solomon Schechter Day School and New

England Jewish Academy. One family member described the impact of being embraced by Greater Hartford's Jewish community:

"Our kids came to Schechter with no English; today they are fluent speakers, they feel at home in school, they have friends. This is our home now . . . we are so grateful to be a part of this community.

"Growing up in Israel, you take Judaism for granted. When you wake up in Israel, you don't have to prove anything. I experience my Judaism here much more than I did in Israel. This bond, this connection with Israel, is the most important connection. We are so grateful to the Foundation and the Federation for helping Schechter make all this possible."

Lillian Fund co-chairs Jessica Esterson and Traci Friedman invited supporters to add \$25 to their \$100 annual gift—and they generously responded! As a result, the Lillian Fund awarded its annual \$10,000 grant to Israel Lemonade Fund in Israel, and two 25th anniversary grants, one \$2,500 grant to Mary's Place in Windsor, CT,

and another \$2,500 grant to Girls Town Jerusalem in Israel.

Launched in 1999, the Lillian Fund is a giving circle of women who share a powerful vision: a world in which all women and children have equal opportunity for professional and personal achievement. They support this vision by awarding annual grants to children's arts and education programs, domestic violence services, mental health counseling and job training, to name a few.

# FY'24 Financials

The Jewish Community Foundation of Greater Hartford has a mandate to fulfill its role in Greater Hartford by maximizing dollars available for making grants today and ensuring that charitable dollars entrusted to it are available in perpetuity.

A well-diversified investment strategy, designed by investment experts, and the generosity of our donors enable JCF to meet these objectives.

## Investment Portfolio

JCF's assets are managed in a commingled investment pool. JCF has a long-term investment horizon with relatively low liquidity needs. For these reasons, the portfolio can tolerate short- and intermediate-term volatility in the interest of generating higher returns over the long-term.

## Financial Oversight

JCF's Investment Committee crafts and implements investment policy and monitors the individual investment managers and their performance. The Investment Committee is assisted by an independent consulting firm, Crewcial Partners, LLC of New York, NY.

The managed investment portfolio includes traditional equity and fixed income investments and alternatives, including private equity, emerging markets and real assets/ commodities. Diversification among multiple asset classes helps to reduce the volatility of JCF's portfolio, moderates market risk, and ensures consistent grantmaking to the community.

## Spending Policy

By using a spending policy, JCF helps ensure that charitable funds will be protected for the future while continuing to have impact today. The policy determines the amount that will be available for grant-making and to support JCF's operating budget. The FY 2024 spending rate was calculated as a percentage of the previous 20-quarters' average ending value of each fund, subject to a floor and ceiling of current fair market value at June 30, 2023.

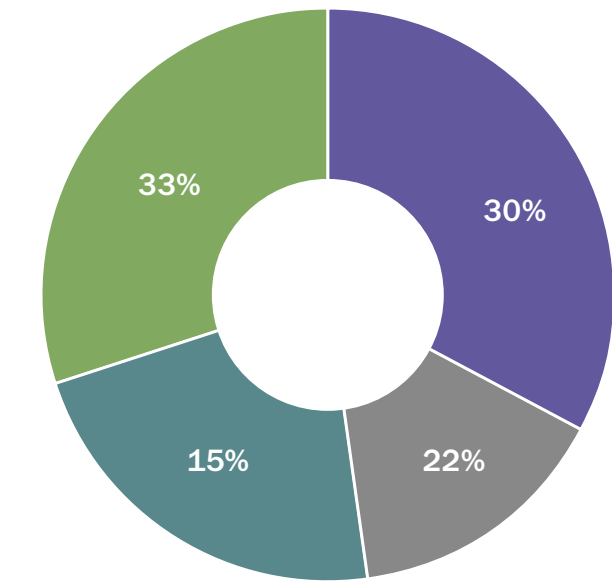

# Funds by Type

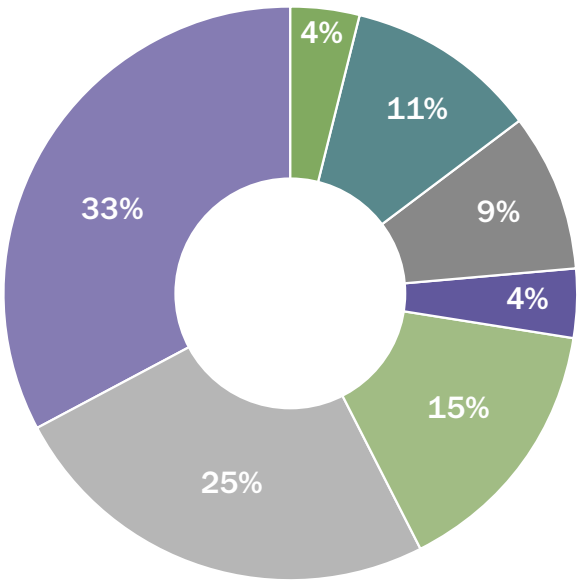
